We respond to around 50 call-outs each year

About 50% of call-outs are to fires – vegetation and property. We also respond to medical incidents, motor vehicle accidents and other requests from people in need.

We need more volunteers

We need more people to help ensure our brigade can respond quickly to emergencies. We have a range of roles available including, firefighters, operational support and administration. We're particularly interested in people who live near the station or work nearby during the day.
